School Play Student Contract

I agree to follow the rules and behavior guidelines of the Westchester Lutheran Middle School Drama Program. Rules include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Everyday, I will come to rehearsal with a positive attitude, strong work ethic and will be respectful of my fellow cast members, the directors, and choreographers. This means I will look at things as opportunities, not difficulties. This means I will work as hard as possible to do the best I can without complaining. This means that I will speak to others in a respectful manner and tone of voice, I will follow directions and I will not cause or threaten physical harm towards others.

2. I understand that the end of the rehearsal schedule is an important time for my cast and me. I will be available for tech week and final dress rehearsals and will clear all conflicts with the director in advance.

3. I will be respectful of the Westchester Lutheran Property, the property the performance facility, the places we may visit and the belongings of others, and the rehearsal and show props. This means that I will not litter, vandalize, steal or destroy items that do not belong to me.

4. I will not go to Mobil for snacks before rehearsal. I will not have food (unless medically necessary) or drinks other than water in rehearsal.

5. I will be on time for rehearsal. On time means that I am ready for rehearsal to begin at the scheduled time (i.e. I have my script, I have gone to the bathroom, and I am ready to work). And I will not leave rehearsal once I have arrived

6. I will maintain my grades. I will do the work required in all my classes and maintain a 2.0 GPA.

7. Cell phones are prohibited at rehearsals. I will keep them put away in my backpack or in the cell phone basket during rehearsal. If I need to use my cell phone I will ask for permission first.

8. I understand that my script is a very important part of the show. If I lose it I will pay \$10 to replace it.

9. I understand that I am allowed to miss a total of 3 rehearsals of scheduled rehearsal time. **IF I MUST MISS A REHEARSAL**, I understand that I am required to clear it with the director at least one week prior. If I miss more than three rehearsals I may not be included in some scenes.

Participants: I have read and understand the Middle School Play Agreement and agree to the contents therein. I understand that not following this agreement may result in consequences that may include: not being allowed at rehearsal for a period of time, forfeiture of a part, removal from the cast.

Parents: By signing this document you acknowledge that you have read and understand the above agreement, that the consequences listed above may be imposed at any time.
