This year for Middle School Musical we are presenting a **Disney's The Little Mermaid Jr.** The performance dates are April 28 - 30. Auditions are open to all students from 6th through 8th grade. For auditions come prepared to perform a song and something memorized to recite (1- 2 minutes long). A Poem or Monologue will work fine. Remember that we are on your side and want you to do well and succeed. So come prepared to put your best foot forward. Take lots of deep breaths. Try practice auditioning in front of small groups of people-like your friends, your siblings, or even your dog, cat, or stuffed animals. The more you practice the more comfortable you'll be.
